*Sherburne County and Wright County, Minnesota Begin eRecording With Simplifile*

**PROVO, UTAH – October 17, 2008** – Simplifile today announced that it has expanded eRecording into two additional counties in the Minneapolis-Saint Paul Twin Cities area. On October 20, 2008, Sherburne County and Wright County, Minnesota will begin electronically recording (eRecording) land record documents such as deeds, mortgages, and reconveyances submitted by title companies, banks, and attorneys through the Simplifile eRecording Service.

eRecording is the process of submitting, receiving, and processing documents for recording via the Internet that have traditionally been sent to the county for recording by runner, express mail, or courier service. eRecording simplifies and accelerates all aspects of the recording process and dramatically improves the county's ability to serve its constituents.

The Sherburne County Recorder's Office is hosting an eRecording kick-off Meeting to introduce the public to eRecording on Tuesday, October 21, 2008 at 10:30 a.m. at the Sherburne County Government Center "Pine A" conference room located at 13880 Highway 10 NW, Elk River, Minnesota.

Additionally, the Wright County Recorder's Office is hosting an eRecording kick-off Meeting on Wednesday, October 22, 2008 at 10:30 a.m. at the Wright County Government Center located at 10 2<sup>nd</sup> St. NW, Room C118 (Sheriff's Hall), in Buffalo, Minnesota.
