LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA BEGINS E-RECORDING WITH SIMPLIFILE

Wilkinson Title First to E-Record with the County

The first electronic recordings which included an Affidavit and several Deeds in Lee County, Florida occurred on November 7, 2008 by Wilkinson Title of Fort Myers, Florida. This first electronic recording ushered in eRecording of documents by title companies, banks, and attorneys to the Lee County Clerk of Court Office through the Simplifile eRecording Service.

eRecording is the process of submitting, receiving, and processing documents for recording via the Internet that have traditionally been sent to the County for recording by runner, express mail, or courier service. eRecording simplifies and accelerates all aspects of the recording process and dramatically improves the County's ability to serve its constituents.
